In February 2014, MJ116, in collaboration with Chang Chen-yue and MC HotDog, released the song "Super Duper Fly" which was selected as the theme song for the Sochi 2014 Winter Olympics. On November 16, 2017, their third album *Big Thing* was released. The album combines various music elements such as experimental electric, ratchet, and soul music. It won wide acclaim. A couple of music videos from the album gained more than a million views online soon after their release.
