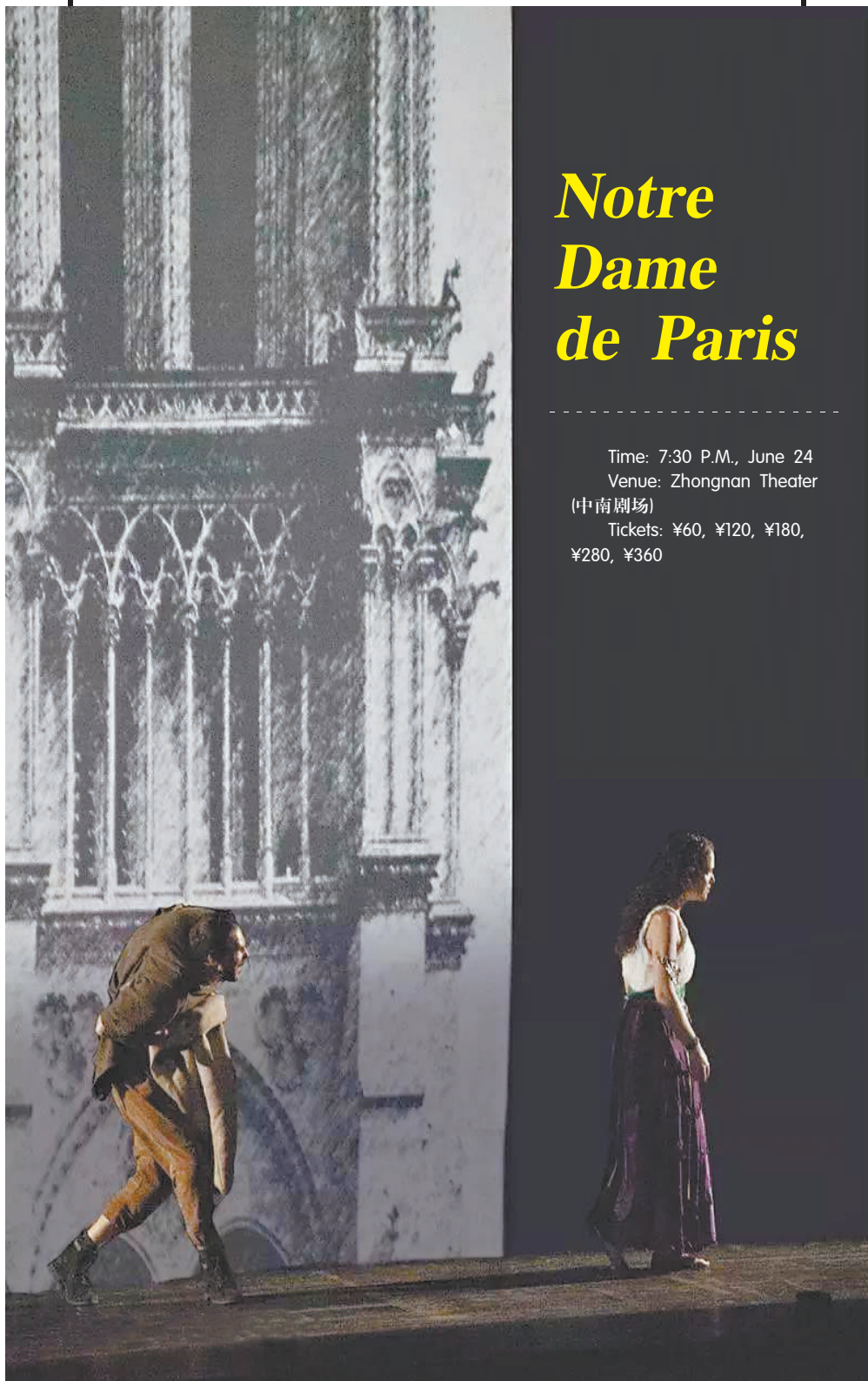

Founded in 1980, the British touring group TNT Theater presents not only English-language plays, but also produces a large number of plays in French, Spanish, and Russian. *Notre Dame de Paris*, directed by Paul Stebbings with a French cast, is the highlight of its French plays. Based on Victor Hugo's novel of the same name, the play provides amazing visual effects. It features moving performances, elegant and lucid French lines, and original music. Chinese subtitles are displayed throughout.

Cloud Man, floating freely in the rhythm of music and poetry, seems to be contradictory to scientist Cloudia. The contrast and conversations between the two demonstrate human curiosity about and the desire to explore the surrounding world and nature. As their two worlds meet, Cloudia, who spends all her life in the pursuit of *Cloud Man*, not only realizes her dreams, but also the meaning of love and freedom. The play was highly praised at the 2011 Edinburgh International Festival. The show has won public acclaim in its sell-out tour since its China premiere in Wuzhen in 2014.

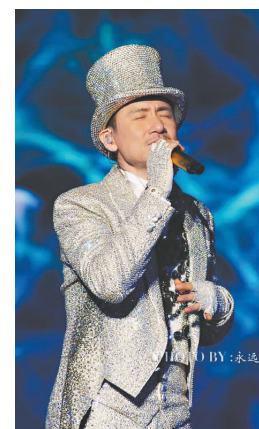
