Wuhan alumni from Shenzhen to invest in 40 projects

An activity was held in Shenzhen on September 4 to invite alumni entrepreneurs to bring their wisdom and capital to invest in Wuhan.

Over 100 entrepreneurs from world-known enterprises like Huawei, TCL and Zowee as well as some distinguished alumni from universities in Wuhan, participated in the event.

In total, 40 projects with an investment value of RMB 101.9 billion were signed. More than half of the projects signed are related to high-end manufacturing and modern service industries.

Starting last year, 11 activities related to the same purpose have been held in

Wuhan. Up to now, over 5,300 alumni have signed onto more than 350 projects with an investment value of approximately RMB 1.5 trillion.

Since the beginning of this year, the government has dispatched work delegations to Japan, the Republic of Korea and Europe, negotiating 44 projects with an investment value of RMB 25.04 billion. Additionally, the government has established six alumni service workstations (communication stations for overseas talent), and has promoted Wuhan East Lake High-Tech Development Zone with Viborg, Denmark, to jointly build the Sino-Danish High-Tech Cooperation Zone.

37 projects signed at Hubei-Hong Kong Trade and Economic Cooperation Fair

On September 4, the Hubei-Hong Kong 2018 Trade and Economic Cooperation Fair was held in Hong Kong, and 37 projects were signed, covering the areas of fiber optics communications, biomedicine, intelligent equipment, new energies, new materials, precision instruments, power electronics, infrastructure and modern services.

The fair has been held for 17 consecutive years.

10 Hubei companies listed in China's top 500 enterprises

The 2018 China's top 500 enterprises list was released on September 2. Of the 10 Hubei enterprises on the list, six are Wuhan-based. The operating income of enterprise to be shortlisted should be no less than RMB 30.69 billion.

500th China-Europe freight train departs Wuhan

The freight train X8017/8 loaded with electronic components, garments, daily necessities and electronic products, produced by enterprises in Wuhan and the cities in the Yangtze River Delta and the Pearl River Delta regions, set off from Wujiashan Station and headed for Hamburg, Germany, on August 31. This was the 500th China-Europe freight train departing from Wuhan since it began operations on October 24, 2012.

The China-Europe freight trains transport not only industrial products manufactured in Wuhan and other cities in Hubei, including optoelectronic products, mobile phones and garments, to European and Asian countries, but also agricultural products. The crawfish from Jingzhou and Qianjiang as well as Yichang oranges have become more popular among Europeans.
